





FY22 Cost-Share Payments




Statewide Cost-Share Allocations vs Payments FY19 – FY23




Executive Order 22-04 – Commission Response

- Grazing in livestock exclusion areas
- Defer grazing school requirement to provide water in grazing system
- Reinstate pond cleanout program
- Allow cover crops to be harvested for livestock feed
- Applies to any district that has a D2 declaration or higher within the county boundaries
- Any contract approved following the variances will need a note type Executive Order 22-04 Drought

Counties Included in Executive Order 22-04 as of August 11, 2022






Sales Tax Revenue







Sales Tax Revenue vs. Expenditures
