Subject: FY 19 Cost-share allocations open and supplemental allocation to follow

A supplemental budget request of \$4.4 million to provide additional cost-share funding for the current fiscal year (Fiscal Year 19) has been signed by Governor Parson.

Effective immediately, the Soil and Water Conservation Program has unlocked the FY19 resource concerns and districts can resume developing and approving new FY19 contracts. Emphasis should be on approving contracts that can be completed and paid in FY19. As a reminder, all FY19 contracts must have a termination date prior to June 14, 2019. In addition, if any FY20 contracts can be completed prior to June 14, 2019, please consider doing a change order moving these contracts to FY19.

The program is planning to do a supplemental allocation on April 25th and will be utilizing the policies for the FY19 Supplemental Allocations.
