

## NOTICE OF ELECTION OF SUPERVISORS

### SWCD BOARD ELECTIONS

Let it be known that the Cape Girardeau County Soil and Water Conservation District will hold an election for one supervisor in each of two different territories in the county. Territory [1] includes Apple Creek and Shawnee Townships and Territory [3] includes Cape Girardeau and Randol Townships. The election will take place from February 1<sup>st</sup> to February 20<sup>th</sup>. Ballots are available to print online at [mosoilandwater.land/cape-girardeau](http://mosoilandwater.land/cape-girardeau). Printed ballots may be returned to the district by mail and must be postmarked no later than February 20<sup>th</sup>. You may also vote in person from 7:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., M-F from February 1<sup>st</sup>- February 20<sup>th</sup>. Please call 1-573-243-1467 ext. 3 to pick up or drop off a ballot at 480 West Jackson Trail, Jackson, MO 63755. Each eligible land representative in the district is allowed one vote. A land representative is defined as the owner or representative authorized by power of attorney of any farm lying within an area proposed to be established, and subsequently established, as a soil and water conservation district under Chapter 278, RSMo. Each farm is entitled to representation by a land representative: provided, however that the land representative is a taxpayer of the county within which the soil and water district is located.

The following qualified candidates will be considered for election:

Territory [1] – Gary Bock, *Shawnee Township*

Territory [3] – Susan Jahn, *Randol Township*

Supervisors manage the administration of district policies and programs, as well as district personnel and funds. The district is supported by the one-tenth-of-one-percent parks, soils and water sales tax.
