**Subject:** Nutrient Management Training and Certification

The Soil and Water Conservation Program is trying to plan a **Nutrient Management training/testing**. This training is through Lincoln University and will be required for those who plan to test to become certified in Nutrient Management. The Nutrient Management certification will allow district staff to sign off on nutrient management plans and is equivalent to the certification held by NRCS staff. The training includes a computer module for the Manure Management Planner (MMP) from Purdue University on developing a plan for commercial fertilizers and then for manure applications.

The training is a precursor to the testing phase to become a certified Nutrient Management planner. The training and testing are only available to district staff who are District Specialist IIIs.

This is a two-day training and will be held from 9:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. each day.
