


Below is an email from ITSD regarding an issues that occurred after an update was done last night. Please follow the instructions below and if you need additional assistance please submit a help desk ticket.

Feel free to share this with users. There was an update that went out last night. It caused PDFs to be reverted to opening with Edge. Below are the instructions for how to set Acrobat back as the default. If they have other issues, they will need to put in a help desk ticket. Some users can't open Acrobat, others have had it removed entirely.

- Right-click the thumbnail of a PDF file, and then choose **Properties**.



- In the file's Properties dialog box, click **Change**.



**Note:**

If your computer settings are managed by a system administrator, you may not see the Change button. Sign in using an administrator account or contact your administrator to get the button enabled.

- Do one of the following:

If you have Acrobat DC or both Acrobat DC and Acrobat Reader DC, choose **Adobe Acrobat DC** and click **OK**.


