Based on the confirmed workshops listed on the agenda for the State Women in Ag conference, the Soil and Water Conservation Program will not allow FY20 state funds to be used for this conference. As stated in the District Operations Manual, "All expenses will be considered ineligible from state grants that do not have a direct correlation or content related to protecting the productive power of Missouri's agricultural land through saving soil or protecting the water resources of the state." The confirmed workshops do not meet this criteria. If the pending workshops are confirmed the program office will consider allowing expenses to this conference from FY21 state funds.

As a reminder if expenses are allowed from FY21 state funds a receipt is needed from the vendor as documentation for the expense. If your district provides a sponsorships to Embassy Suites then a receipt is needed from Embassy Suites.
