Good afternoon,

The FY 22 cost-share supplemental process will start next week. MOSWIMS will be locked at 4:00 PM on August 5th to run the fund status report to determine eligibility.

To be eligible for supplemental allocation(s), districts must have obligated at least 90 percent of their total FY21 allocation in a resource concern. If the district does not have enough funds to obligate a pending contract, that contract must be preapproved by the district coordinator. In the event that the district has funding to obligate any other pending contract(s) (including the status of pending contract approval or pending contract submission) in that resource concern, those contracts must be obligated for the district to be eligible to receive the supplemental allocation. An allocation amount of \$100,000 will be provided to the district in Sheet/Rill and Gully Erosion. All other qualifying resource concerns will be allocated \$75,000. Districts will be allowed to refuse a supplemental allocation in a specific resource concern by sending a request via email to the program office (soil&waterconservationprogram@swcd.mo.gov) and copy Tammy Cody (tammy.cody@dnr.mo.gov) by 4 p.m. on the Wednesday preceding each supplemental allocation.
