Preparing for Microsoft 365

The ITSD is in the process of migrating the current Microsoft experience to Microsoft 365 (M365) as part of our Digital Government Transformation (DGT) Initiative portfolio of projects.

After months of preparation and testing, the team is excited to announce that the Microsoft Applications (Apps) deployment and Microsoft Exchange migrations will begin in October 2023.

When will I see changes?

Due to the scope of this upgrade the state is conducting a phased implementation (timeline graphic provided below). Deployment and migration across the state agencies will begin in October 2023 and continue through July 2024. Currently DNR is slated for a deployment in late December 2023.



What does this mean for me?

Microsoft Applications (e.g. Outlook, Excel, Word, PowerPoint, etc.) will upgrade, offering greater functionality. After the migration, you will access Microsoft applications differently and more seamlessly.

What happens next?

You will be receiving continued communication through email, much of which you will be receiving one month before any changes will occur at DNR. Please ensure you watch for email announcements and next steps to prepare you for implementation. These communications will contain key details such as pre-migration tasks, how to log in after migration, and where to get help if needed.

How do I learn more?
