Good afternoon.

On March 1, 2023 Governor Parson's drought Executive Order 22-04 expired. Based on the commission's motion at the July 25, 2022 commission meeting, the practice policy variances expire when the executive order expires. The expiration of this order will not affect any current board approved contracts that utilized the variances. No new contracts can be approved based on the commission's variances.

The department is aware some parts of the state have not fully recovered from the drought and the Drought Assessment Committee is planning to monitor the situation as we move forward into Spring.
