In preparation of a possible federal government shutdown, the program wants to remind districts of the changes that were made to the log in process to access email via Webmail. Below is an email that was forwarded to the districts earlier this year. At the bottom of the email is a user guide link with instruction on how to setup Multi-Factor Authentication. The setup process has to be done while connected to the state network. If access is needed to your district email account if the shutdown does happen, the setup needs to be completed before the end of the week. The districts Active Directory credentials will be username@ads.state.mo.us. The username is used when logging onto the computer and to MOSWIMS (nrname).

Additional guidance will be sent for districts to consider if the shutdown happens.

Hello Team,

Earlier, on March 18 and 19, ITSD made initial changes to how you log in to Webmail and the Virtual Private Network (VPN). This is all part of the Digital Government Transformation project which will bring Multi-factor Authentication (MFA) to remote users.

We are now approaching the next phase of this project, which will roll out MFA to your agency on May 21.

In preparation for this, all users who connect remotely to Webmail or the VPN will need to know how to setup their MFA to connect to those services.

Please review the attached Okta user guide, which will prepare you to log in to your Okta account and guide you through the setup process with one of the listed options.

Additionally, the Office of Cyber Security will be offering WebEx training sessions for those who would like to see and understand the setup process, and the available setup options, before beginning the process yourself.



From May 1-5, WebEx training sessions will run twice a day at 9:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m.
