

## NOTICE OF ELECTION OF SUPERVISORS

### Marion County SWCD Board Elections

Let it be known that the Marion County Soil and Water Conservation District will hold an election for one supervisor in each of two different territories in the county. Territory II includes Fabius Township and Territory IV includes Liberty, Miller and Mason Townships. The election will take place from February 1<sup>st</sup> to February 20<sup>th</sup>. Ballots are available to print online at <https://mosoilandwater.land/sites/mosoilandwater/files/MARION.pdf>. Printed ballots may be returned to the district by mail and must be postmarked no later than February 20<sup>th</sup>. You may also vote in person from 8:00 A.M. to 4:30 P.M. at the Marion County Soil & Water Conservation District office located in the USDA Service Center in Palmyra, MO. Each eligible land representative in the district is allowed one vote. A land representative is defined as the owner or representative authorized by power of attorney of any farm lying within an area proposed to be established, and subsequently established, as a soil and water conservation district under Chapter 278, RSMo. Each farm is entitled to representation by a land representative: provided, however that the land representative is a taxpayer of the county within which the soil and water district is located.

The following qualified candidates will be considered for election:

Territory II – David A. Porter, Fabius Township

Territory IV – Bradley M. Bier, Liberty, Miller and Mason Townships

Supervisors manage the administration of district policies and programs, as well as district personnel and funds. The district is supported by the one-tenth-of-one-percent parks, soils and water sales tax.
