**CODY SASSMANN HAS BEEN WORKING DILIGENTLY TO INSTALL** GRAZING SYSTEMS ON THE FAMILY FARMS. IN ADDITION TO ALL OF THE CROP GROUND, HE IS WORKING TO IMPROVE THEIR PASTURE GROUNDS AND HERD HEALTH. HE HAS COMPLETED SEVERAL PROJECTS IN A TIMELY MANNER THESE PAST COUPLE OF YEARS. THEY HAVE INSTALLED WOODLAND FENCES, PIPELINE AND TANKS AND EVEN COMPLETED A WELL CLOSURE THROUGH OUR OFFICE.

THEY HAVE STARTED INCORPORATING COVER CROPS ON THEIR FARM GROUND AND CONTINUE TO INCREASE THEIR PASTURE FIELDS WITH ADDITIONAL GRAZING SYSTEM INSTALLATIONS.
