GascSWCD Chairman Mike Haeffner was pleased to present Harold Roethemeyer and his family with this year's Conservation Family Award. Harold has been a cooperator since 1993. His farm is mostly row cropped and he has been very active addressing erosion concerns on his property. In 2012, he installed a dry hole structure and washcob in order to slow down the drainage on his farm and stop the active gully erosion. The year after it was constructed, he graciously hosted a farm tour on this site for others to see.

He has utilized the Pest Management Practice and the Cover Crop Practice through his operators. This past year, he addressed another erosion issue by installing a washcob diversion. He was greatly pleased with the project, as well as our assistance in getting the project designed and completed. He also was an active CRP cooperator. With the assistance of the 1/10 of 1% Parks and Soil and Water Sales Tax, the District is able to financially support landowners, like Harold, to complete conservation practices in order to conserve our natural resources.
