SUBJECT: Natural Disaster Assessment Deadline Extended to November 15, 2011

In response to the unprecedented weather events this calendar year, the Soil and Water Conservation Program asked districts to submit information regarding damages sustained by existing conservation practices and to determine what new practices were needed as a result of these events. Seven districts have submitted assessments identifying needs to be fulfilled through an additional allocation of funding. These requests were approved by the Soil and Water Districts Commission during the conference call on Friday, September 9, 2011; however, due to the continued flooding in parts of the state, the deadline for submission has been extended 60 days until Tuesday, November 15, 2011.

This will provide additional time for districts that are still recovering from weather events to submit information regarding the effects of these disasters. For additional information on what should be submitted, please refer to MEMO 2012-001. Any additional requests will be presented to the commission at the November meeting at the training conference.
