SUBJECT: DSP 3 Grazing System Per Acre Maximum Changes

A resolution passed during the Missouri Association of Soil and Water Conservation Districts (MASWCD) Annual Meeting proposed an increase to the per acre limits for the DSP 3 Grazing System practices. The Soil and Water Districts Commission asked the Plan for the Future Current Practices Committee to review the request and make a recommendation to the commission.

During the April 20, 2017, Soil and Water Districts Commission meeting, the commission reviewed recommendations from the practices committee. Based on the recommendation, the commission approved increasing the per acre maximums for the following Grazing System practices for contracts board approved after July 1, 2017:

DSP 3.1 Water Development	\$110/acre
DSP 3.2 Water Distribution	\$120/acre
DSP 3.3 Fence	\$70/acre

The Cost-Share Handbook will be updated with the new maximums for these practices as well as the Missouri Soil and Water Information Management System (MoSWIMS) during the rollover process.
