SUBJECT: Mileage Change

The Office of Administration has notified the program that effective July 1, 2019, the state mileage allowance rate will be increased to 43 cents per mile. Mileage reimbursed to district employees and supervisors traveling on district business cannot exceed 43 cents per mile from state funds. If your district reimburses mileage at a higher rate, the difference between 43 cents and your mileage rate must be paid from local funds.

RE: State Standard and Fleet Mileage Reimbursement Rates

Beginning July 1, 2019, the state standard mileage rate for Fiscal Year 2020 will increase to 43 cents per mile. In addition, the State Fleet rate will increase to 28 cents per mile. These rates should be used in accordance with the State Vehicular Travel Policy, which may be found at: <https://oa.mo.gov/sites/default/files/sp12vehicular.pdf>
