ABOUT THE MISSOURI CRCL PROJECT

The Missouri Climate-Resilient Crop & Livestock (CRCL) Project aims to promote climate-resilient crop and livestock systems through diverse practices. To reach a wide range of farmers, we're introducing eight tailored incentive payment initiatives. On **November 6th**, farmers will be able to apply for our cover crop practice payments, first-come first serve.

AVAILABLE INCENTIVE PROGRAMS

REGENERATIVE GRAZING

Incentive payment to implement regenerative grazing with biodiverse forage species, managed intensive grazing, and low-cost watering and fencing approaches

Payment per acre: \$50

NUTRIENT MANAGEMENT

Incentive payment to implement appropriate nutrient management practices that include use of the 4R nutrient stewardship approach, and split-nitrogen application

Payment per acre: \$20

CLIMATE-SMART FIELDSCAPES

Program for small and underserved farmers to implement climate-smart fieldscapes, comprised of at least three stacked climate-smart practices that will serve as demonstration sites

\$10,000 spread across 3-year contract
