



BEEF FINISHING FACILITY

Beef Finishing Facilities offered through SWCD are a practice to take cattle from an existing outdoor feed-lot situation and put them in a covered building with a concrete floor with the purpose of mitigating the water pollution from runoff and capture those nutrients to be applied in a planned and controlled manner.

SWCD can cost share 75% of the state average cost of constructing a facility up to \$100,000.

To qualify for a facility you must have a confined outdoor feeding area. Call Bollinger Co. SWCD to discuss the project and get an estimate of cost-share. Next, obtain a Comprehensive Nutrient Management Plan (CNMP) written by a qualified Technical Service provider. Once written, provide the CNMP to the SWCD. SWCD will then create a contract. After contract approval the facility can be started. Facilities are sized to the number and size of cattle that are present in the operation and included in the CNMP.
