COST SHARE SIGN-UP

The Linn County Soil & Water Conservation District will be holding its annual cost share sign up August 1st through August 31st 2021. <u>The sign-up will be held via phone call</u> and in the office.

This sign-up will begin for Fiscal Year 2024 which runs from July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024.

Cost-share will be allocated through a continuous list system beginning on September 1, 2022. One last sign-up and drawing will be held from August 1-August 31, 2022. The drawing will be held in the following order.

- 1. Landowners who have signed up 4 years in a row.
- 2. Landowners who have signed up 3 years in a row.
- 3. Landowners who have signed up 2 years in a row.
- 4. Landowners who have signed up 1 year.

The drawing will be the beginning of the continuous list system. Landowners will be able to begin signing up on this list September 1, 2022 but will go to the bottom of the list if requested after the drawing is complete. Landowners will be able to sign up any time of year after this.

Guidelines

- Each landowner (defined by SSN or TIN associated with the ground) can only be on the list one time per SSN or TIN.
- No trading sports on the list with other landowners.
- There will be no skipping and coming back to landowners if they are not ready. If a landowner is not ready for any reason they will be moved to the bottom of the list.

There will also be money set aside (up to \$30,000) to use on cover crop practices. There will be a separate list kept for this practice. Landowners can be on both lists. Each landowner or operator will be limited to \$5,000/year maximum.

Just a reminder that if a landowner receives cost share assistance this fiscal year (July 1, 2022-June 30, 2023) you will not be allowed to sign up this coming year.

This is 75% cost share assistance with the maximums being \$30,000 for terraces, \$20,000 for ponds and other maximums vary depending on the practice. You will have the option of signing up for cost share on cover crops again this year. You are able to sign -up for cover crops and 1 other practice.

FISCAL YEAR 2022 COST SHARE UPDATE

The cost share for fiscal year 2022 came to an end in June. The District ended the year spending \$469,445.20 for 26 Linn County landowners to control erosion. There were 14 Terrace Practices (DSL-44) and 11 Ponds (DWC-1).

Our fiscal year 2023 cost share got underway July 1st with an allotment of \$553,186 in Sheet and Rill/Gully Erosion, \$4,000 in Grazing Management, and \$2,000 in Sensitive Areas.
