

NOTICE OF ELECTION OF SUPERVISORS
RIPLEY COUNTY SWCD BOARD ELECTIONS

Let it be known that the Ripley County Soil and Water Conservation District will hold an election for one supervisor in each of two different territories in the county. Territory [I] which includes *(Pine, Kelley and Shirley Townships)* and Territory [III] which includes *(Flatwoods, Washington, Varner, Thomas and Harris Townships)*. The election will take place from **February 1 to February 20, 2024**. Ballots are available to print online at *(mosoilandwater.land/ripley)*. Printed ballots may be returned to the district by mail and must be postmarked no later than February 20th. You may also vote in person from *(8:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.)* at *(the Ripley County SWCD office, located in the USDA Service Center, 63 Confederate Ridge Road, Doniphan, MO 63935)*. Each eligible land representative in the district is allowed one vote. A land representative is defined as the owner or representative authorized by power of attorney of any farm lying within an area proposed to be established, and subsequently established, as a soil and water conservation district under Chapter 278, RSMo. Each farm is entitled to representation by a land representative: provided, however that the land representative is a taxpayer of the county within which the soil and water district is located.

The following qualified candidates will be considered for election:

Territory [I] – Mary Scott – (Pine Township)

Territory [III] – Chuck Aldrich (Harris Township)
