
Wednesday morning will start with a light breakfast in the hospitality room, Rural Crimes workshop and a closing luncheon.



History of Women In Agriculture Conferences &

The first State Women In Ag Conference was held in 1995. The 5 regions in Missouri (Northwest, Southwest, Central, Northeast & Southeast) host the State Conference on a rotational schedule. Women have been to Hannibal, St Joe, Columbia, Springfield, Cape Girardeau, Blue Springs, Jefferson City, St Louis, Joplin, Kirksville, Branson, Boonville, Chillicothe, Farmington & Excelsior Springs. Every year each venue offers interesting and useful workshops, hospitality room and silent auction and a banquet with entertainment. Speakers are present during opening sessions and closing sessions. Tuesday's are the tour day where ladies get to experience the area and see what types of agriculture, agribusiness, state parks and see areas that are the focal point of the region. This is a great way to learn more on all avenues and types of agriculture, business of farm records and personal, home décor using the outdoors, health, mind and wellness. The Women In Ag Conferences are designed to benefit all women from all walks of life and even Men too. Typically the State Conference is held in September and is a 3 day event.

There is a Regional Women In Ag Conference held in Marshall every March that is a 1 day event. The Mid-Mo Women In Ag is held every March/April in California, Mo and is a 1 day event. The OMG AgriPride Women In Ag is held every August/September in Owensville, Mo and is an evening event. There are several counties that host a Women In Ag Meeting/Event, you would need to check with your County.

Grundy & Mercer Counties are planning their 2nd NW MO Women In Ag Night. This event is slated for Thursday, October 19th at Barton Campus. More details will be released as the plans progress.

Kids Corner – Recipe

Home Made Top Tarts!



Ingredients

- 1 (15 ounce) package refrigerated pie crusts
- 1/4 cup strawberry jam, divided
- 2 cups confectioners' sugar
- 2 tablespoons milk
- ½ teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1 tablespoon colored decorating sugar, or as needed

Directions

- 1. Preheat oven to 425 degrees F (220 degrees C). Line baking sheets with parchment paper.
- 2. Unroll the pie crusts, place on a lightly floured work surface, and roll the crusts slightly with a rolling pin to square the edges. Cut each crust into 8 equal-sized rectangles. Place about 2 teaspoons of strawberry jam in the center of 8 squares, and spread the jam out to within 1/4 inch of the edge of the pastry square. Top each with another pastry square, and use a fork to crimp the squares together, sealing in the jam. Use a knife to trim the pastries, if desired. Move the filled pastries to the prepared baking sheets.
- 3. Bake in the preheated oven until the edges are lightly golden brown, about 7 minutes. Allow to cool on the baking sheets. Meanwhile, stir together the confectioners' sugar, milk, and vanilla extract in a bowl to make a spreadable frosting. Spread the cooled tarts with frosting and sprinkle with colored sugar.
